Skidoo/lynx Halo Install

To install your Ski-Doo/Lynx Halo lights, follow these clear and straightforward steps:

- 1. **Remove Hood:** Carefully take off the hood of your Ski-Doo/Lynx to access the internal components.
- 2. **Access Light Housing:** Remove the insulation found underneath the hood to reveal the light housing.
- 3. **Detach Light Housing:** Carefully remove the entire light housing for easier installation of the Halos.
- 4. **Conceal Wiring:** Run the Halo wires between the light and its housing to keep them hidden and organized.

- 10. **Wire Integration:** You have options here either use a plug pigtail, a Y-splitter, or a scotch lock to splice into the wires securely.
- 11. **Final Check:** Once installed, your Halos will illuminate whenever the machine is running, enhancing visibility and style.
